Subject: Get your Annual Mammogram in the Mobile Mammography Van

The City of Albuquerque is once again making it easier for employees to prevent and detect breast cancer early by supporting the mobile mammography van at various city locations. Employees are allowed 30 minutes to attend a screening appointment with prior approval from their supervisor. The mobile mammography van will be available for employees and family members at the locations listed below. As always, there is no charge for the mammogram.

Getting a mammogram, a simple screening test that checks for changes in breast tissue, can help find breast cancer early. Finding breast cancer when it is small and in its earliest stage increases the chance for successful treatment. Doing regular physical activity and keeping a healthy weight can help prevent breast cancer.

HOW TO SCHEDULE YOUR MAMMOGRAM APPOINTMENT:

- Call (505) 332-6967 or toll free (877) 771-6266.
- Call the scheduling number to confirm acceptance of your insurance. Presbyterian Health Plan and other health insurance plans will be accepted.
- Schedule at least 11 months since your last mammogram, at age 40 or older for your first mammogram, or if you have a referral from a health care provider to get one sooner.
