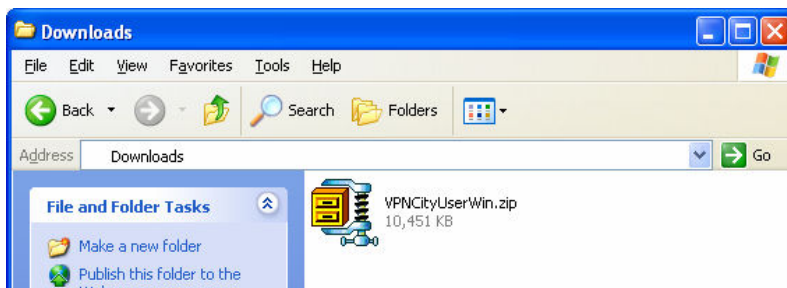


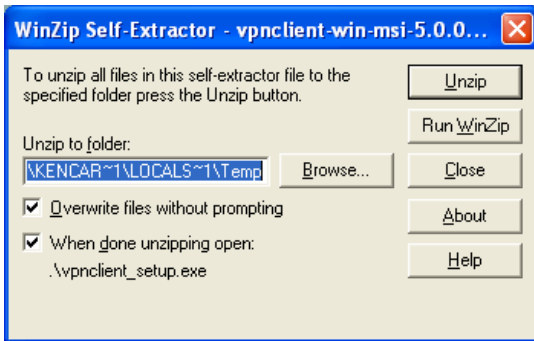
# Cisco VPN Client software installation and connection procedure for Win XP/2000/Vista

*This document is in reference to the complete City User VPN package which can be downloaded from <http://netcontrol> when using the City of Albuquerque network.*

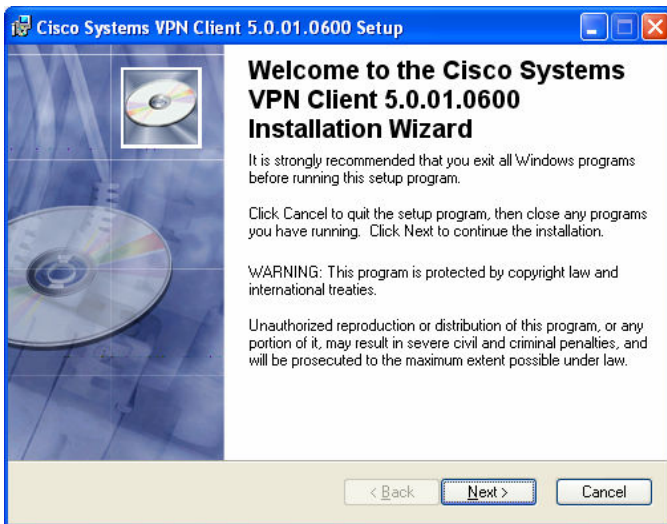
1) Open the **VPNCityUserWin.zip** file. Extract all of the files into any folder.



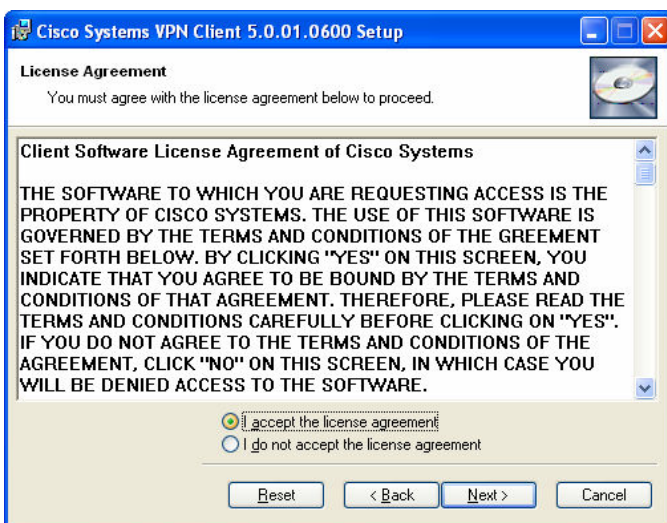
2. Run the file **vpnclient-win-msi-5.0.07.0290-k9.exe** from the folder you extracted the files to. Click **"Unzip"**. This will start the installer for the VPN Client.



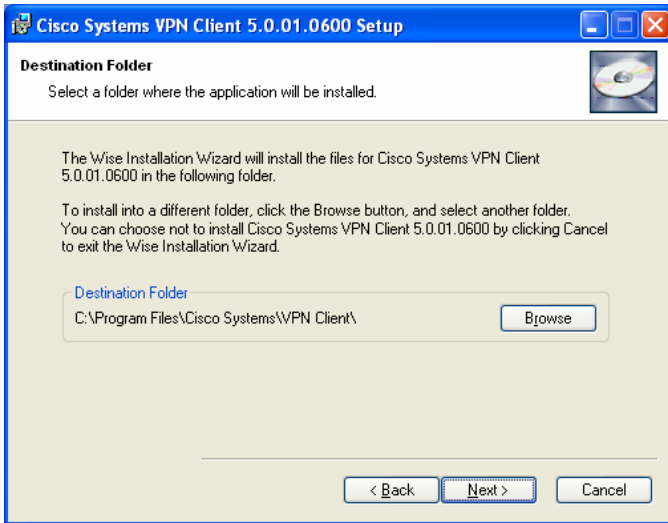

5. Copy the file **Cityuser.pcf** to your hard drive. This file can be obtained from <http://netcontrol> from inside the city's network.

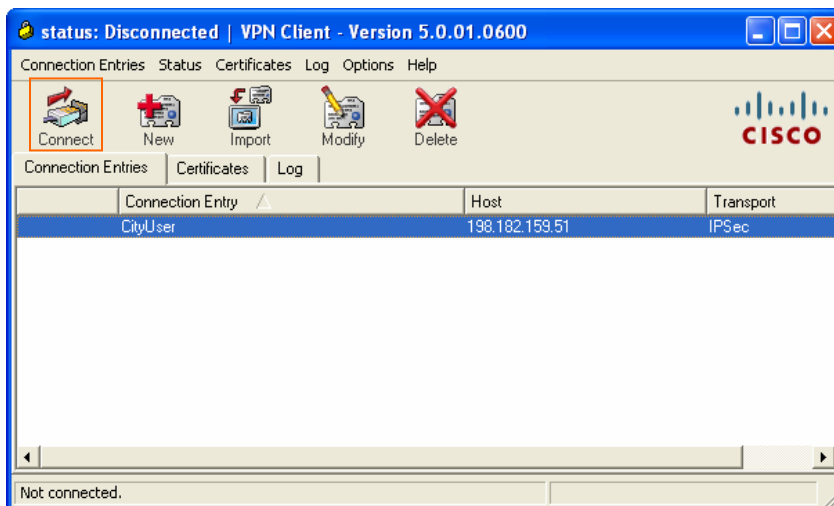
***Make sure you are connected to the internet and can browse to your favorite web page before attempting to connect to the City's network with VPN!***

4. Open Cisco VPN client from **Start > All Programs > Cisco Systems VPN Client** folder.



Click the **Import Button**, and choose the connection profile (PCF file) that you downloaded. Choose the file **Cityuser.pcf** from your hard drive.

6. Click "Connect"

7. Enter your VPN username and password. You are now connected to the City. If you have Novell on a city owned laptop that you are using outside the city, right-click on the "N" in the bottom right and choose "Novell Login" --- This will load your network drives.
